Title Page	The Title Page should read: Master the GED® Test
Page 14	The second paragraph should read: The 2014 GED® test is scored with a “standard score” system in which the number of correct answers on each GED® test is converted to a 1100–200 scale. As of March 1, 2016, most states have lowered the minimum score to pass the 2014 GED® test to 580 across the four-test battery, with a minimum score of 145 for each separate test. In addition, GED® Testing Service recommends that states retroactively apply the new scoring levels to test-takers who tested since January 1, 2014. Depending on each state’s decision, students who previously earned scores of 145–149 may now be eligible for their state’s high school equivalency credential. Page 170	The second paragraph below the gray box should read: Read sentence 4 straight through. The clause after the comma sounds incomplete. Adding <i>and</i> and deleting the comma transforms the second clause into a dependent clause, connected to the original main clause by the word <i>and</i> . The correct answer is (D).
Page 564	The final segment of the explanation for The Addition Subtraction Method should read: Subtract Equation B from Equation A, thereby eliminating x , and then isolate y on one side of the equation: $\begin{array}{r} 2x - 6y = 6 \\ 2x + y = 4 \\ \hline 0x - 7y = 2 \\ -7y = 2 \\ \\ y = -2/7 \end{array}$
